Summer Registration:

- Seniors who have completed their success steps in advance (Assessment, Orientation & have an Ed Plan on file) will be able to register during **Priority 3** beginning at 7:00am on Wednesday, May 3<sup>rd</sup>. Otherwise, registration will take place during Open Registration beginning on Monday, May 8<sup>th</sup>.
- Registration for high school concurrent students takes place during Priority 6 and begins at 7:00am on Friday, May 5<sup>th</sup>. High School students should submit their [Concurrent Enrollment forms](#) as soon as possible, but preferably not later than May 1<sup>st</sup> in order to allow time for processing before the Priority 6 registration cycle starts. Admissions and Records will accept and process forms as they are received, and will continue to do so even after registration has begun. Keep those forms coming in!

### Counseling 270 Offered During Spring Break

We highly encourage students to sign up for Counseling 270 during the spring semester. There are far fewer sections offered this summer, so students should plan ahead! There are other sections listed in the online Schedule of Classes, but the two listed below are conveniently scheduled during spring break. If these classes don't get adequate enrollment, it's possible that they'll be cancelled...students should register as soon as possible. Don't forget that [Concurrent Enrollment forms](#) are required for Seniors taking the class while still in high school.
