***New!* Spring 2017 Registration Happening Now**

If they haven't already done so, please encourage students to submit their Concurrent Enrollment forms so that they are able to enroll in their spring classes as soon as possible. We are recommending that Seniors enroll in **Counseling 270** during the **spring semester** in order to get this success step completed while the enrollment fees are waived as a concurrent enrollment student.

➤ In addition to completing Assessment and Education Planning, Seniors will need to complete Counseling 270 during the spring semester or before June 20th during the summer session in order to be granted Priority 3 registration status for Fall.

Interim Assessment Tool

Santa Rosa Junior College has transitioned to a new and interim assessment tool for math and ESL placement effective November, 2016. The MDTP test for math, and the CELSA test for ESL are administered through a computerized platform (CAPP). Students are encouraged to utilize our [test preparation materials located on our website](#). The transition in testing platforms extends the length of time a student must allow for full assessment and placement. It also limits the ability to accept late arrivals. The math test can last up to two hours, and the ESL test up to one hour. The English test has not changed and still remains at two hours in length. The interim use of this tool will be in place until the Statewide common assessment tool ([CCCAssess](#)) is ready for full implementation.
