Some details to understand how online learning works:

- Students must have computer access with internet, ability to run Flash and headphones
  - Equipment may be checked out to students if needed
- Students must have a working Google petk12 gmail account for communication with teacher
- Students are required to spend a minimum of two hours per week during the following office hours:

- Students are strongly encouraged to start coursework as soon as possible! Office hours are available June 16, 10:00 - 12:00 to enroll ahead of time
