**William J. Bianchini Memorial (\$500)
(ORIGINAL PHS APPLICATION & ATTACHMENTS ONLY- NO
EXTRA COPIES NEEDED)**

Eligibility: Must plan to attend a two or four year college or university,
express an interest in agriculture and agricultural work experience preferred.

**Robert Brockman Memorial Scholarship (\$500)
(ORIGINAL PHS APPLICATION & ATTACHMENTS ONLY- NO
EXTRA COPIES NEEDED)**

Eligibility: Must plan to attend a two or four year college or university, have
played varsity soccer for a minimum of two years, and demonstrate financial
need.

**Eric and Sue Bunker (\$1,000)
(ORIGINAL PHS APPLICATION & ATTACHMENTS ONLY- NO
EXTRA COPIES NEEDED)**

Eligibility: Must have a 3.0 GPA, have an after-school or summer job, and
be involved in sports. Student must be going to a two or four year college,
or vocational/technical school.

California Scholarship Federation (CSF) (\$250 x 2)
(PHS Application – 4 complete stapled sets)

Eligibility: Student must be an active CSF life member, participate in our community service activities and plans to attend a career school or a two or four year college.

Cinnabar Educational Foundation (\$500 x 2) DUE: 1/31/17

(PLEASE RETURN APPLICATION TO MRS. STOLL)

(ORIGINAL PHS APPLICATION & ATTACHMENTS ONLY- NO EXTRA COPIES NEEDED)

Eligibility: Attended Cinnabar School or Cinnabar Charter School for at least 4 years, and intend to further studies with an emphasis in the field of technology at the college level. (Technical schools will be recognized.)

Requirement Essay: Include an essay explaining how attending Cinnabar School affected how you feel about continuing your education.

Florence Padron Memorial Nursing Scholarship (\$500 x 2)
(PHS Application – 4 complete stapled sets)

Eligibility: Must plan on attending a two or four year college, excels in science, and has a strong desire to become a registered nurse. There is preference given to those who are from disadvantaged backgrounds and demonstrate financial need.

John Ferina Memorial Scholarship (\$300)
(PHS Application – 4 complete stapled sets)

Eligibility: Must be a Penngrove Elementary School graduate, still reside in Penngrove and intend to use the money for college

Liberty Elementary School Foundation (\$500 x 4)
(ORIGINAL PHS APPLICATION & ATTACHMENTS ONLY- NO EXTRA COPIES NEEDED)

Eligibility: Must be a graduate of Liberty School.

Requirements: Essay: Please describe the volunteer services you have provided for Liberty School.

McDowell Drug Task Force (\$250)

DUE: April 14, 2017

(Students mail scholarship application directly to donor)

*** Separate donor application only required. No extra copies needed. See Mrs. Stoll in the College & Career Center for the application.**

Eligibility: GPA of 2.0 or better, completion of 40 or more hours of community service, going into a field of education, health services, public safety, counseling or environmental

Requirements: Essay: Discuss the type of community service projects you have been involved in, as well as your career goals.

McNear Elementary School (\$300 per year for four years) (PHS Application – 4 complete stapled sets)

Eligibility: Must have attended McNear School and intend to go to a four year college.

Petaluma High School Athletic Boosters (\$300-\$500) (Multiple Scholarships)

*** Separate donor application only required. No extra copies needed. See Mrs. Stoll in the College & Career Center for the application.**

Eligibility: Applicant must be planning to attend a two year or four year college, must have earned a block letter in a varsity sport, have a minimum 2.5 GPA, and family must be a current member of the Athletic Booster Club. One letter of recommendation must be from a high school coach.

Petaluma Chapter of Realtors-\$1,000 DUE: March 6, 2017

*** Separate donor application only required. No extra copies needed – See Mrs. Stoll in the College & Career Center for the application.**

(STUDENT WILL MAIL COMPLETED APPLICATION DIRECTLY TO DONOR)

Eligibility: This scholarship is available to students whose career plans are related to the field of business or a service oriented industry. Cumulative GPA must be a 2.0 or better.

Petaluma Junior High School Polly Klaas Scholarship

(\$250-\$500)

(ORIGINAL PHS APPLICATION & ATTACHMENTS ONLY- NO EXTRA COPIES NEEDED)

Eligibility: Student must be a PJHS graduate with minimum 2.75 GPA and must have participated in performing arts and/or music in high school. Students planning to pursue college major in performing arts are strongly encouraged to apply.

Petaluma High School PTSA (\$300 x 3)

(PHS Application – 4 complete stapled sets)

Eligibility: Must have at least a 3.0 GPA, and the family must be a current PTSA member. Student is planning to attend a career school or college.

Petaluma Riding and Driving Club (\$500) (Due: 4/1/17)

(Application will be available January 1, 2017)

*** Separate donor application only required. No extra copies needed. See Mrs. Stoll in the College & Career Center for the application.**

(Students are to mail the application directly to the donor.)

Eligibility: Must be a member of FFA, Petaluma Junior Riders, 4-H or District 2 Junior Rodeo.

Petaluma Valley Rotary/Harold Alexander Scholarship

(Four \$1,000 scholarships – available to **PHS, Casa, St. Vincent's, San Antonio, Carpe Diem, Sonoma Mountain and Valley Oaks High Schools**)

***Separate donor application only required. No extra copies needed.
See Mrs. Stoll in the College & Career Center for the application.**

Eligibility: GPA of 3.0 or above. Be active in a leadership role or as an active, contributing participant in school sponsored, or community activities that benefit the community or portions of the community. Demonstrate leadership qualities, but not necessarily as “the leader” of a group or activity. Student must have active involvement, whether as the leader or working behind the scenes or quietly facilitating a project to ensure success. A student who acts as a catalyst to get a project started, or keeps a project “on track”, encourages others, or is the “go to person”, but is not necessarily the one in charge is very worthy of inclusion in this scholarship.
(Highest consideration is given to those students who demonstrate a passion for community service).

Petaluma Woman's Club (\$1,000) (PHS Application – 4 complete stapled sets)

Eligibility: For any senior girl who has demonstrated good citizenship, leadership, and service to the community and to further a higher education.

Hazel Schwobeda Memorial (\$1,000)

***Separate donor application only required. No extra copies needed.
See Mrs. Stoll in the College & Career Center for the application.**

Eligibility: Must have attended a public high school in Petaluma for at least three years, going to a two or four year college, GPA of at least 3.20, demonstrate financial need, academic potential and good citizenship.

Requirement: Essay: Discuss your school and community involvement, employment record, educational and career goals, as well as your financial need.

Abe Tenenbaum Memorial (\$1,000)

***Separate donor application only required. No extra copies needed.
See Mrs. Stoll in the College & Career Center for the application.**

Eligibility: 40% need, 40% academics, 20% activities, GPA 3.5 or above.

**Wilson School/Annie Arfsten PTA Scholarship(\$250)
(ORIGINAL PHS APPLICATION & ATTACHMENTS ONLY- NO
EXTRA COPIES NEEDED)**

Eligibility: Must have graduated from Wilson School, has demonstrated the school motto: "Working to be our best, every day!" in a variety of ways such as: academics, service to the community, sports, band, leadership or other activities while in High School.
